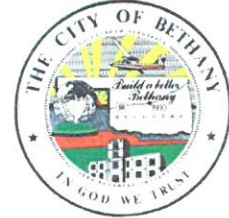

Then, attendees will travel to the next location for the purpose of a ribbon cutting at the corner of NW 30th Street and N Peniel Avenue in Bethany, Oklahoma related to the Federal ARPA Grant Peniel Sanitary Sewer Force Main Project and GO Bond Proposition 1-H Peniel Avenue (west half) - NW 25th Street to NW 30th Street Reconstruction Project.

Finally, attendees will travel to the Bethany Fire Station located at 3919 N Rockwell Avenue for the purpose of a ribbon cutting ceremony related to the GO Bond Proposition 3-A Fire Station Addition project.
